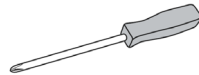

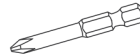

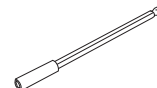

NOTE: Hardware packs are included in packaging. You may receive more hardware than needed. Discard any extra hardware after assembly.



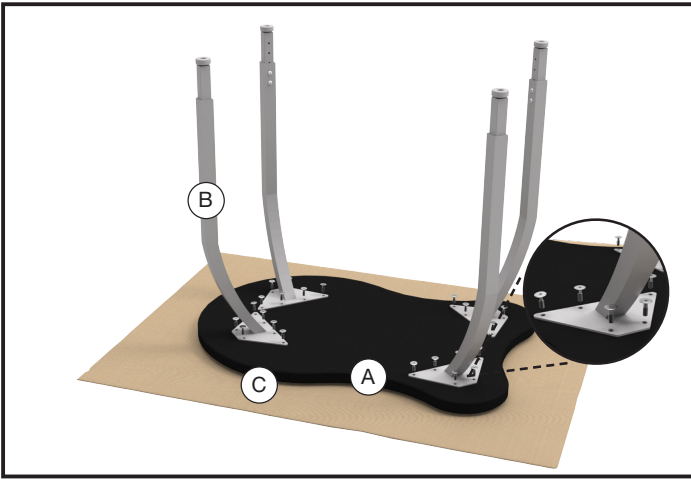
CAUTION! Some parts may have sharp edges. Care must be taken when handling various pieces to avoid injury. For your safety, wear a pair of work gloves when assembling.

ASSEMBLY

1. Place **Part A** face down on a protected flat surface so threaded inserts are facing up.
2. Align pre-drilled holes in **Part C** (that is attached to **Part B**) with threaded inserts in **Part A**.

Using a screw gun, 4mm hex bit and a drill bit extension, connect **Part C** to **Part A** using **Hardware G**.

Repeat this step for the remaining legs.

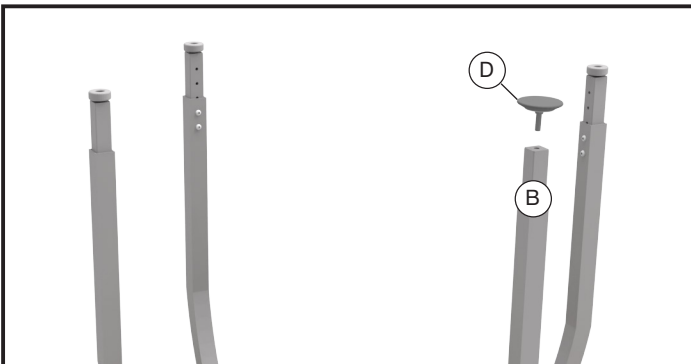


3. If your table requires **Hardware H**, align the bar(s) with the pre-drilled pilot holes in the top, attach using **Hardware J**.

4. If **Hardware D** or **Hardware F** was ordered, remove nylon glide from leg by rotating counter-clockwise until glide is free from **Part B**.

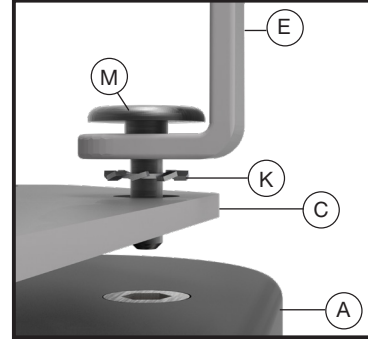
Place stem of **Hardware D** or **Hardware F** into the hole of the leg. Rotate clockwise until fully inserted into the leg.

Tighten with a 14mm open-ended wrench (only with dual-wheel casters.)

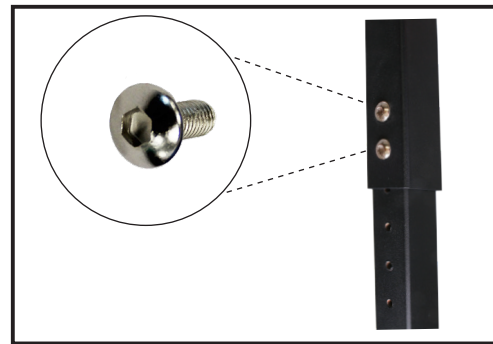


NOTE: Casters are not to be used as a leveling device. Please make sure that casters are tightened all the way to prevent possible damage to the stem of the caster.

5. If **Hardware E** was ordered, place **Hardware M** through the backpack hook, then through **Hardware K**. Fasten through **Part C** to **Part A**.



6. Adjust legs to desired height while the desk is still face down on a protected flat surface.
7. Using the provided hex wrench, turn both M6 bolts (located at the bottom of the most-outer tube of the leg) counterclockwise, until the inner tube of the leg moves up and down freely.
8. Adjust the leg to the desired height. Using the wrench, turn both M6 bolts clockwise until fully tightened. Repeat for the remaining legs.



9. With assistance, turn desk upright.
